

# Waste sorting guide – How to sort your waste at LiU

### Α

#### Address labels

Residual waste.

## Advertising flyers/brochures

Newspaper/return paper.

## Aluminum foil/aluminum packaging

Metal packaging. Make sure these are reasonably clean from food residues.

## Aluminum can

With deposit = deposit.

Without deposit = metal packaging.

#### **Balloons**

Residual waste.

## Ballpoint pen

Residual waste

#### **Bandages**

Residual waste.

#### **Batteries**

Batteries, special containers.

#### Binders

Residual waste or LiU Reuse, alternatively recycling center for reuse.

#### **Books**

Hardcover: residual waste.

Paperback/softcover: newspaper/return paper. Possibly LiU Reuse or recycling center for reuse.

#### **Bottle**

In glass (no deposit): clear or colored glass packaging.

In plastic (no deposit): plastic packaging.

With deposit: deposit.

## **Bottle caps**

In metal: metal packaging.

In plastic: plastic packaging.

### **Bubble wrap**

Small quantities: plastic packaging.

Large quantities: contact Post and House Services if needed or go to the recycling

center.

## C

#### **Calculator**

Electronic waste.

### Candles (paraffin/stearin)

Residual waste.

#### Cannulae

Handle as sharp waste. See the Laboratory Safety Manual for more information.

#### Cardboard

Packaging: paper packaging.

Corrugated cardboard: corrugated cardboard. Contact Post and House Services if

needed.

## **Carrier bags**

In paper: paper packaging. In plastic: plastic packaging.

### CD case

Residual waste.

## CD/DVD/Blu-ray discs

Residual waste.

### CD player

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or go to recycling center for reuse.

#### **Ceramics**

Whole: LiU Reuse, or recycling center for reuse.

Broken: not recyclable (landfill). Contact Post and House Services if needed.

#### **Chemicals**

Hazardous waste. See Laboratory Safety Handbook for more information.

#### Chip bag

In paper: paper packaging. In plastic: plastic packaging.

#### Clock/watch

Non-functioning: electronic waste. Remove battery if possible and sort it

## separately.

Functioning: LiU Reuse, or recycling center for reuse.

### **Coffee cup**

Not recyclable, landfill.

### Coffee filter/coffee grounds

Food waste.

### Computers/laptop

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

## **Computer accessories**

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

### **Computer monitor**

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

## **Corrugated cardboard**

Paper packaging in sorting room. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

## Dish brush

Residual waste.

### Dish soap bottle

Plastic packaging.

#### **Dishcloths**

Residual waste.

### Dishwasher detergent

Hazardous waste.

## Disposable cup

In plastic: plastic packaging. In paper: paper packaging.

## Disposable plate

In plastic: plastic packaging. In paper: paper packaging

## Drinking glass (whole and broken)

Not recyclable, landfill. Contact Cleaning Services if a suitable sorting container is missing.

#### **Electrical cables**

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

### **Empty paint cans**

In metal: metal packaging.

With residues left: hazardous waste.

### **Envelopes**

Residual waste. If you remove glue/plastic parts, they can be sorted as paper.

#### **Eraser**

Residual waste.

## **Flashlight**

Electronic waste. Remember to remove the battery first and sort it separately!

#### Fluorescent tube

Light sources. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

## Flyer/brochure

Newspaper/return paper.

## Food waste/leftovers

Food waste.

## Frigolite/Celluar plastic

In small quantities: plastic packaging

In large quantities: sorting room or recycling center. Contact Post and House Service if needed.

#### Fruit waste

Food waste.

#### **Furniture**

LiU Reuse system or recycling center.

#### G

#### Gift ribbon

Residual waste.

## Gift wrapping paper

Paper packaging.

### Glass jar

Colored or clear glass packaging.

#### **Glass bottle**

Without deposit: colored or clear glass packaging. With deposit: deposit.

#### Glue

Hazardous waste.

## Gypsum/plaster

Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

#### Н

### Halogen lamp

Light sources. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

### Household paper

Small quantities: food waste. Larger quantities: residual waste.

#### Household roll

Paper packaging.

## Headphones

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

#### Ink cartridge for printer/copiers

Taken care of by the supplier during printer maintenance.

## J

#### Jar

In aluminium: metal packaging. In plastic: plastic packaging. In paper: paper packaging.

## Jar lids

In plastic: plastic packaging. In metal: metal packaging.

## **Keyboard**

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

### Laboratory waste

Handled according to the Laboratory Safety Handbook.

## Laminated paper/plasticized paper

Residual waste.

#### LED lamp

Light sources, sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

#### Lid

In metal: metal packaging. In plastic: plastic packaging.

## Light bulb (incandescent)

Light sources. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

## Low-energy lamp (CFL)

Light sources. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

#### M

#### Marker pen

Residual waste.

## Metal tube

Metal packaging.

## Mechanical pencil

Residual waste.

#### Milk carton/package

Paper packaging. Must be empty.

## Mirror glass

Not recyclable (landfill). Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

## Mobile phone

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

#### **Monitor**

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.

### Moving box

Corrugated cardboard in sorting room. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

#### Ν

#### Nails & screws

Metal scrap. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

### **Napkin**

Residual waste.

### **Needles/syringes**

Handled as sharp waste. See Laboratory Safety Handbook for more information.

### **Newspapers**

Paper/return paper.

#### **Notebooks**

Newspaper/return paper.

#### Office paper

All "white paper," magazines, and advertising are sorted as newspaper/return paper.

## Padded envelope

Residual waste.

#### Paint can

In metal: metal packaging

With residues remaining: hazardous waste

#### **Paint residues**

Hazardous waste. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed

#### **Paintbrush**

Used: hazardous waste.

#### Paint brush cleaner

Hazardous waste.

#### **Paperclip**

Residual waste.

## Paper towel roll

Paper packaging.

### Paper roll

Paper packaging.

## Paper bag

Paper packaging.

## Paper plate

Paper packaging. Must be empty and reasonably clean.

### Paper cup

Paper packaging. Must be empty and reasonably clean.

#### **Pens**

Residual waste.

#### **PET bottles**

Deposit.

## Pizza box

Paper packaging. Must be empty and reasonably clean.

## Plaster (band-aid)

Residual waste.

## Plastic box (hard plastic)

Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

## Plastic bag/carrier bag

Plastic packaging.

## Plastic cup

Plastic packaging. Must be empty and reasonably clean.

## Plastic film/wrap

Plastic packaging.

## Plastic gloves/rubber gloves

Residual waste.

## Plastic jar

Plastic packaging.

## Plastic sleeve (document protector)

Residual waste.

### Polystyrene/styrofoam

Small quantities: plastic packaging.

Large quantities: sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House

Services if needed.

## Porcelain (broken)

Not recyclable (landfill). Sorting room, or recycling center. Beware: shards may be harmful for staff. Contact Cleaning Services if needed.

#### Post-it notes

Residual waste.

### Printer/copier cartridges

Handled by supplier during printer maintenance.

#### R

#### Radio

Electronic waste. Remove any batteries first.

## **Receipts**

Newspaper/return paper.

#### Remote control

Electronic waste. Remember to remove the battery first and sort it separately!

#### **Rubber gloves**

Residual waste.

### **Rubber band**

Residual waste.

## S

#### **Scissors**

Metal scrap. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

## **Shredded paper**

Newspaper/return paper.

#### **Slovents**

Hazardous waste.

#### **Smoke detector**

Electronic waste. Remember to remove the battery and sort it separately!

### Spray can/bottle

Hazardous waste. Sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

### **Staples (small metal pins)**

Residual waste.

#### **Straw**

In plastic: plastic packaging. In paper: paper packaging.

### Styrofoam/polystyrene

Small quantities: plastic packaging.

Large quantities: sorting room, or recycling center. Contact Post and House

Services if needed.

#### Т

#### **Tape**

Residual waste.

#### Tea bag

Food waste.

#### **Tealight holders**

Empty tealight cups (aluminum casing): metal packaging. Remove wick.

#### **Textiles**

Curtains in good condition: LiU Reuse.

Other textiles: textile recycling.

#### **Thermometer**

Electronic thermometers: electronic waste. Mercury thermometers: hazardous waste.

### Tin can

Metal packaging.

#### **Tools**

Non-functioning: electric or battery-powered tools = electronic waste. Other tools: metal scrap at recycling center.

#### TV

Non-functioning: electronic waste, or recycling center. Contact Post and House Services if needed.

Functioning: contact DIGIT, or recycling center for reuse.
